- 5. Everyone is subject to a temperature check upon entry. If there is an indication of a fever, the individual will be asked to leave.
- 6. It is the responsibility of each individual to practice safe health practices to mitigate their potential exposure outside of the lab out of consideration for those in the lab. If anyone encounters someone that has recently tested positive for COVID-19, it is the individual's responsibility to NOT come into the lab and instead to e-mail the lab staff of their health status. It is also the individual's responsibility to NOT come into the lab if (s)he shows symptoms of any illness.
